Up to 2015-16, the Students Council used to be formed as per the Maharashtra Universities Act 1994 Section 40 (2) (b) (v), and the Guidelines of the Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University, Aurangabad.

The University Act was revised in 2015-16, and has been enforced from the year 2017-18.
