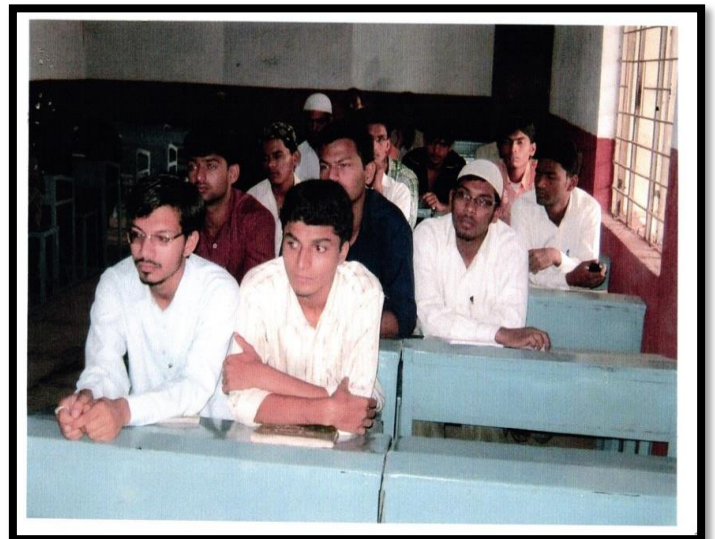

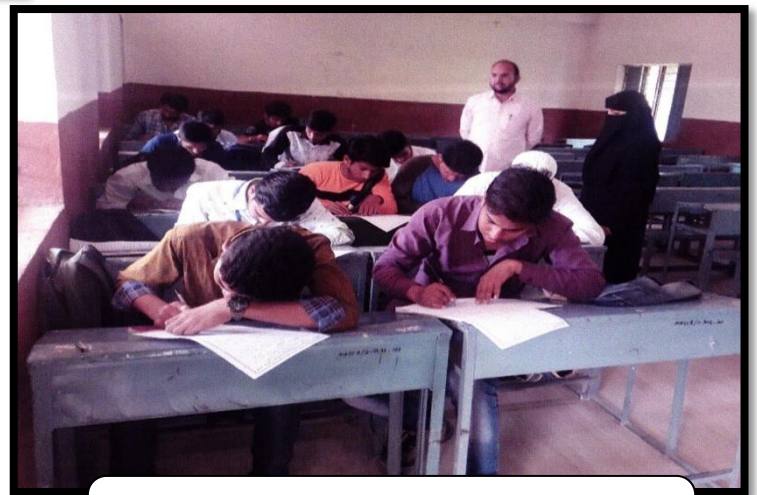
# Academic Year 2017-2018

## Speech Competitions

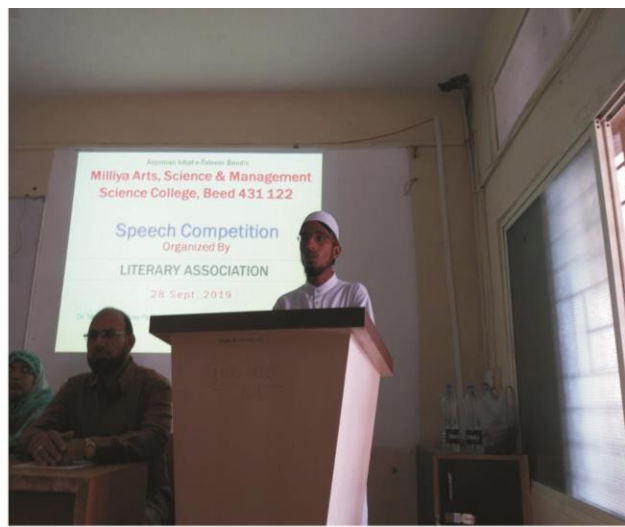
- Literary Association organized Speech competitions on 28-09-2019.
